The Cathedral City Fire Department will host Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training at our Administration Building in March, 2022. Administration is located at 32100 Desert Vista Rd.

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program educates volunteers about disaster preparedness for the hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. CERT offers a consistent, nationwide approach to volunteer training and organization that professional responders can rely on during disaster situations, allowing them to focus on more complex tasks.

Our class schedule is as follows:

- Thursday, March 17, 6PM to 9PM
- Friday, March 18, 6PM to 9PM
- Wednesday, March 23, 6PM to 9PM
- Thursday, March 24, 6PM to 9PM
- Saturday, March 26, 8AM to 4PM

Attendance for all classes is required to receive certification.

This training is free for residents of Cathedral City, \$50 per person for non-residents. Each participant will be provided a student manual and a CERT kit (backpack).
