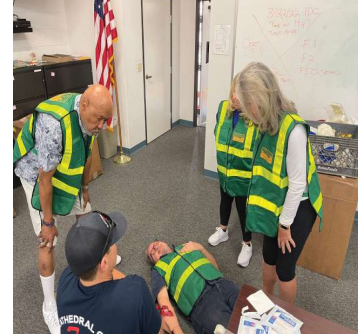

CERT training promotes a partnership between professional emergency services and the people that they serve. The goal is for emergency personnel to train members of neighborhoods, community organizations, and workplaces in basic emergency response skills. CERT trained members enhance the emergency response capability for their area, by providing valuable assistance until help can arrive.



WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

PREPAREDNESS:

Introduction to disasters, their impact, and the hazards posed by building and non-structural items. Emphasis on the role of CERT in many disaster scenarios.

FIRE SUPPRESSION:

Identifying and reducing potential fire hazards, basic fire suppression strategy, fire fighting resources, and fire fighting techniques.

MEDICAL OPERATIONS and PATIENT ASSESSMENT:

Treatment strategies for life threatening conditions and the principles of triage. Patient assessment and treatment for multiple types of injuries.

PSYCHOLOGY:

Understanding the stresses of being a disaster service worker, how to cope with those stresses for yourself and others.
